Planning Commission:

Discussed uses for the ARPA money for the town parking lot, the county has decided they will not to the paving.

Discussed Wyatt Porter's conditional use permit. Joe Miller provided feedback on decisions by the BOA designating a Contractor Storage Yard and regulations.

Paul provided an update on the solar farm and provided insight into the Public Service commission and the DNR involvement

Agenda:

Paul Mahler was in attendance to provide some clarification around the Towns involvement in the Solar farm project. He stated the Town has no authority on this project. They can provide input to the PSC for or against but cannot stop the project. Dan Weatherly (resident) brought up numerous concerns about the project, wanting the Town to take some action. He suggests various things we could possibly do. Paul Hueg invited Dan to share his information with him and try to come up with some sort of plan going forward.

Waste Management – The road restrictions will apply to all roads in the spring, motion by Miller/Wynveen second.

Town Hall Rental – tabled; we will continue to have Paulette do the renting of the Town hall while we look at changing the process.

Roads: Will have LRIP this year – 7 years to complete the project. Will review the roads in the Spring.

Chair: Paul talked about our water study at the Town Hall, the report was good. Bob Aune will conduct a bacteria test for the town.

Fire Inspection – planning will be working on an ordinance for fire inspections.
